- I. **MEMBERS PRESENT:** Heidi Cantwell, Melody Korth, Donna Barnes, Stephanie Barnard, Anne Silva, Yin Lawler, Mary Danna, Kim Norris, and Judy Martinez Sign in sheet attached.
- II. **CALL TO ORDER:** The general meeting of the ANHS Pep Squad Booster Club was called to order on June 9, 2009 at 7:10pm.
- III. **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:** We did not have meeting minutes to approve, due to no meeting minutes taken from the last board meeting and handed over to this board.
- IV. **REPORTS:**

Melody Korth seconded the motion. Motion carried. **Planner Ads:** It was mentioned that planner ads are a profit sharing program and every ad sold gets points towards the profit that is split. This money goes into the individual accounts. **Kids Camp:** Donna Barnes made the motion and Melody Korth seconded the motion and the motion was carried that the kids camp revenue from the mass mailings will go into the general fund and the revenue from the camp with a name on the flyer will go to the individual accounts. Kid's camp attendees will receive a t-shirt, poms, and ribbons and perform the first half of the Varsity game. **Spiritwear:** Kim Norris showed examples of possible spiritwear options. Options shown were: pj pants, scarves, and beanies. Other options discussed were sweatshirts, zip hoodies, thermal tops and a jersey. It was recommended that we re-visit the spiritwear at the next board meeting due to the time.

 - E. **Uniform Update:** Warm ups have been ordered, quotes are in for uniforms. Team Threadz was the best price.
